# Arenal Volcano



## How to get here

Arenal Volcano is an active andesitic stratovolcano in north-western Costa Rica around 90 km northwest of San José, in the province of Alajuela, canton of San Carlos, and district of La Fortuna.

From the conference location (TEC): 37 km - 50 minutes by car.

# Rincón de la Vieja National Park



## How to get here

Rincón de la Vieja (from Spanish, «Corner of the Old Woman») is an active andesitic complex volcano in north-western Costa Rica, about 23 km from Liberia, in the province of Guanacaste, inside the National Park with the same name.

From the conference location (TEC): 200 km – 3 hours and 40 minutes by car.

## How to get here

The Celeste River is located in Guatuso, Alajuela, in the Tenorio Volcano National Park.

San José is the capital and largest city of Costa Rica. Located in the mid-west of the Central Valley, San José is the seat of national government, the focal point of political and economic activity.

# Liberia



## How to get here

Liberia is the capital and largest city of Guanacaste province, Costa Rica.

# Monteverde



## How to get here

Monteverde, Costa Rica is a small community in Puntarenas, Costa Rica, located in the Cordillera de Tilarán. Roughly a four-hour drive from the Central Valley, Monteverde is considered a major ecotourism destination in Costa Rica.

From the conference location (TEC): 140 km – 3 hours and 50 minutes by car.



# Nicoya Peninsula



## How to get here

The Nicoya Peninsula is located on the Pacific coast of Costa Rica. It is divided into two provinces: Guanacaste Province in the north, and the Puntarenas Province in the south.

From the conference location (TEC): 200 km – 3 hours and 30 minutes by car.





# Tamarindo Beach



## How to get here

Tamarindo is a town and district of the Santa Cruz canton, located on the Nicoya Peninsula on the Northern Pacific coast of Costa Rica in the Province of Guanacaste.

From the conference location (TEC): 260 km – 4 hours and 10 minutes by car.





# Conchal Beach



## How to get here

Playa Conchal is in the northern area of Guanacaste, one of the most famous sites in Costa Rica, which has a large tourist infrastructure and numerous natural attractions in which its beaches stand out.

From the conference location (TEC): 250 km – 4 hours and 10 minutes by car.



# Marino Ballena Beach



## How to get here

Ballena National Marine Park is one of the most unique reserves in Costa Rica. Located just offshore along the Central Pacific coast in South Puntarenas.

# Manuel Antonio Beach



## How to get here

Manuel Antonio National Park, on Costa Rica's central Pacific coast, encompasses rugged rainforest, white-sand beaches and coral reefs.

## How to get here

Corcovado is a National Park on the Osa Peninsula, southwestern Costa Rica, which is part of the Osa Conservation Area.

From the conference location (TEC): 400 km – 6 hours 40 minutes by car, plus a trip on boat.



# Limón



## How to get here

Limón is one of seven provinces in Costa Rica. The majority of its territory is situated in the country's Caribbean lowlands, though the southwestern portion houses part of an extensive mountain range known as the Cordillera de Talamanca.

From the conference location (TEC): 200 km – 3 hours by car.

## How to get here

# Gandoca Manzanillo Wildlife Refuge



## How to get here

The Gandoca Manzanillo Wildlife Refuge is situated in one of the most stunningly beautiful regions of Costa Rica. Located just a few kilometers north of the Panama border in Talamanca County.

From the conference location (TEC): 275 km – 4 hours and 30 by car.
